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
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

Week One

ph as in dolphin and trophy Learning Objective:

Teach the sound of the phonetic combination "ph", which is 'f' as in dolphin and trophy.

As your student completes page 4 this week ensure that they say the sound 'f' (as in dolphin and trophy), as they write each ph combination.

While they work on pages 5-6 this week, encourage them to say the sound "f" as in dolphin (or trophy)", as they write each word.

If your student already completed Phonics with Penmanship Book One, then you could add a challenge and ask them to say each sound (both letters and phonetic combinations) in the entire word as they write it.




